General Maintenance

- Periodic vacuuming is recommended to prevent airborne dust from building up on the wallcovering surface. The frequency of vacuuming should be increased in particularly polluted environments.

Cleaning

- The wallcoverings are finished with Teflon to provide increased protection against staining from most water and oil agents.
- When splashed, the contaminant will form beads on the surface of the wallcovering, and, in most cases these can be removed by gentle blotting with a clean absorbent tissue.
- Remove any such splashes when still wet, but do not rub as you may push them into the wall material and create a stain.
- Once stains are dried in it is very difficult to remove them. You may try gentle rubbing with a clean sponge or cloth dampened with a little neutral detergent solution, but make sure it's not too wet. Always work from the outside in towards the center of the stain.
- In the case of coffee, tea, fruit juices, etc. which can discolor once dry, try gentle dabbing with a neutral detergent solution, followed by lemon juice and finally dab with a clean dry cloth to remove any excess moisture.
